Supporting Work-Integrated Learning placements in the construction industry.

Eligibility
How To Apply
Reimbursement

Your Construction Associations have received funding from the Alberta Government to support Work-Integrated Learning placements in the construction industry.

Wage subsidies of 50% (maximum subsidy \$5,000) are available to hire current post-secondary students and recent grads (up to 6 months) for temporary work experience placements at least 3 weeks in length, which can take place at any time during the year.

Placements can be engineers, technologists, accounting and finance, human resources, IT, logistics, procurement, safety, marketing, etc.



Eligibility

Must be in the construction industry and based in Alberta

Candidates must be a current post-secondary student or recent graduate (within 6 months)

Student Placements

Placements can be in any aspect related to the industry

Placements must be related to the students post-secondary studies in a meaningful way.

Labour or apprenticeships are not eligible.

Primary place of work must be in Alberta.

Step 1 - Provide us with your company information.

Step 2 - Submit an application for each student placement.

Step 3 - Submit a student application to fill a placement, or ask us how we can help you find potential candidates.
